

KNIT BEARD HAT

used in conjunction with Knit Mustache Pattern

Yarn:

Bulky/Chunky

I recommend [Lion Brand Homespun](#) or [Red Heart Light & Lofty](#) (or similar)

Notes:

This pattern creates the beard and hat in one flat piece to be seamed together. The beard is knit first, from left to right, then extra stitches are cast on for the hat. Skills needed include Provisional Cast On, Kfb, K2tog. Piece is worked in garter stitch (knit each row).



Gauge:

10 sts + 16 rnds = 4 in. (10 cm) in St st (k every rnd) on larger needle. BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make a 4 in. (10 cm) square, try using smaller size needles; if more stitches and rows, try larger size needles.

Beard:

CO: Provisional cast on 6 stitches

Rows 1-6 : Knit

Row 7 : Knit to last 3 sts, kfb, kfb, k (8 stitches at end of this row)

Row 8 : Knit

Row 9 : Knit to last 3 sts, kfb, kfb, k (10 stitches)

Row 10: Knit

Row 11: Knit to last 3 sts, kfb, kfb, k (12 stitches)

Row 12: Knit

Row 13: Knit to last 3 sts, kfb, kfb, k (14 stitches)

Row 14: Knit

Row 15: Knit to last 3 sts, kfb, kfb, k (16 stitches)

Row 16: Knit

Row 17: Knit to last 3 sts, kfb, kfb, k (18 stitches)

Row 18: Knit

Row 19: Knit to last 3 sts, kfb, kfb, k (20 stitches)

Row 20: Knit

Row 21: Knit

Row 22: Knit

Row 23: Knit to last 5 stitches in row, k2tog, k2tog, k (18 stitches)

Row 24: Knit

Row 25: Knit to last 5 stitches in row, k2tog, k2tog, k (16 stitches)

Row 26: Knit

Row 27: Knit to last 5 stitches in row, k2tog, k2tog, k (14 stitches)

Row 28: Knit

Row 29: Knit to last 5 stitches in row, k2tog, k2tog, k (12 stitches)
Row 30: Knit
Row 31: Knit to last 5 stitches in row, k2tog, k2tog, k (10 stitches)
Row 32: Knit
Row 33: Knit to last 5 stitches in row, k2tog, k2tog, k (8 stitches)
Row 34: Knit
Row 35: K1, k2tog, k2tog, k (6stitches)
Rows 36-41: Knit

Create Hat:

Row 42: Cast on 16 stitches. Pick up and knit provisional cast on stitches for beard.
Cast on another 16 stitches.

Rows 43+ Continue to knit each row (garter stitch) or knit RS, purl WS (stockinette stitch) until piece measures 8" from row 42 (the beginning of the hat)

BO Bind off, leaving a long tail

Finish Hat:

Seam Using a tapestry needle, seam together edges of hat with yarn tail.

Cinch Cinch top of hat by threading yarn through the top edge and cinching into a tight circle. Knot off yarn tail and thread end through knitting.

Mustache Knit mustache and sew in place



KNIT MUSTACHE PATTERN

to be used in conjunction with knit beard hat pattern

Notes:

This pattern starts at one point of the mustache and works across to the other. Piece is worked in garter stitch (knit each row). Gauge will depend on the size of yarn.



Mustache:

CO 1

Row 1 : Kfb (2 stitches at end of this row)

Row 2 : Knit across

Row 3 : Kfb, kfb (4 stitches)

Row 4 : Knit

Row 5 : Kfb, k2, kfb (6 stitches)

Row 6 : Knit

Row 7 : Knit

Row 8 : Knit

Row 9 : K2tog, k2, k2tog (4 stitches)

Row 10: Knit

Row 11: k2tog, k2tog (2 stitches)

Row 12: Knit

Row 13: Kfb, kfb (4 stitches)

Row 14: Knit

Row 15: Kfb, k2, kfb (6 stitches)

Row 16: Knit

Row 17: Knit

Row 18: Knit

Row 19: K2tog, k2, k2tog (4 stitches)

Row 20: Knit

Row 21: k2tog, k2tog (2 stitches)

Row 22: Knit

Row 23: K2tog (1 stitch)

BO

Attach Sew onto beard hat

CO (cast on)	Kfb Knit into front and then back of same st - 1 st increased.
BO (bind off)	K2tog Knit next two stitches together - 1 st decreased.
