

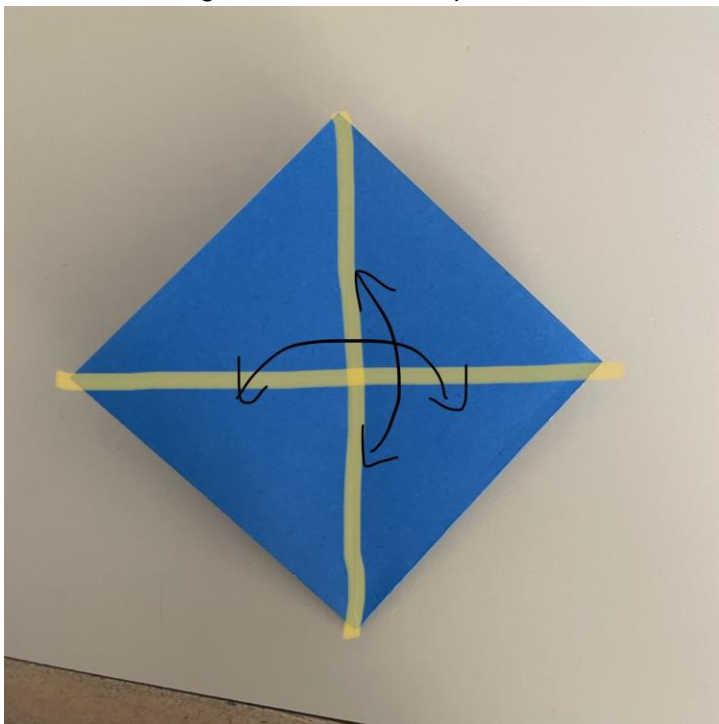
The reason why I made it is because origami flowers won't die differently from real flowers. You can enjoy this bouquet permanently.

First I'm going to tell you how to make Iris with origami.

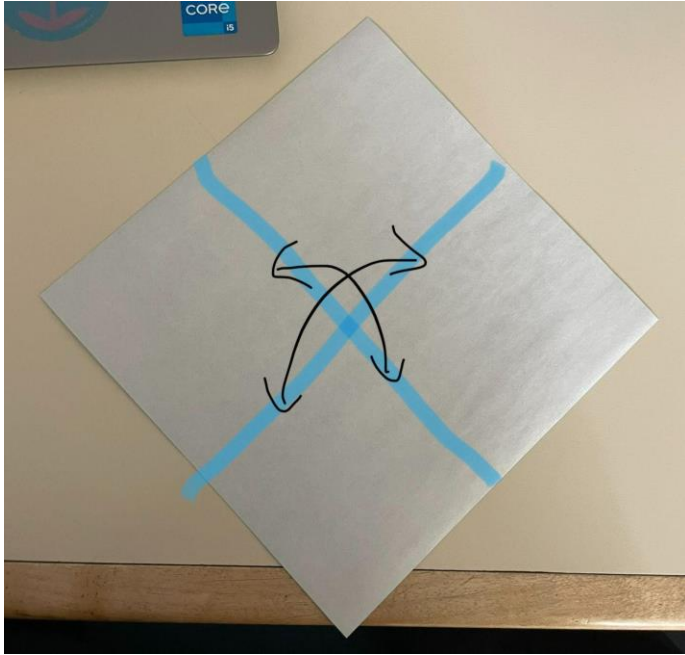
Iris



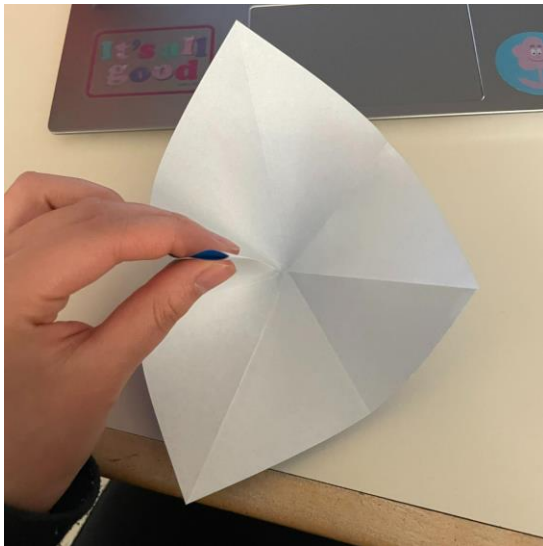
1, Place the origami colored side up and fold it in half with lines.



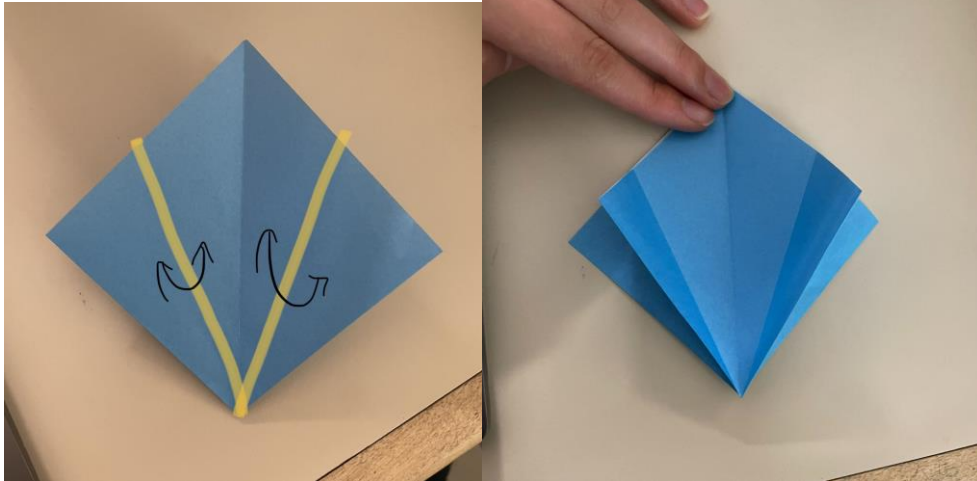
2, turn over. Fold in half at the dotted line and crease.



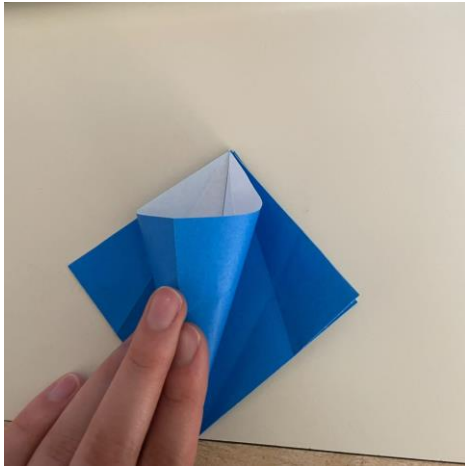
3, Fold along the lines.



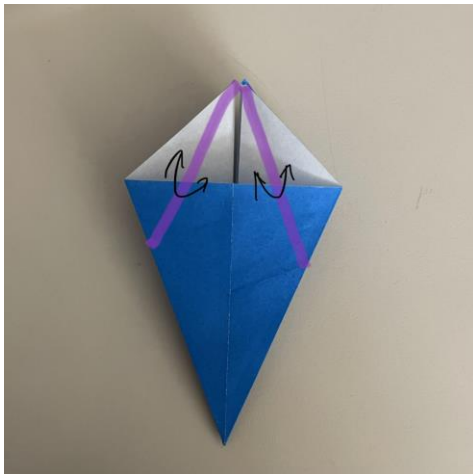
4, Turn one sheet over and make a fold line. Do the same thing on the other side.



5, Fold along the fold line, opening and crushing the corners. Turn the origami over and fold the remaining three sides in the same manner.



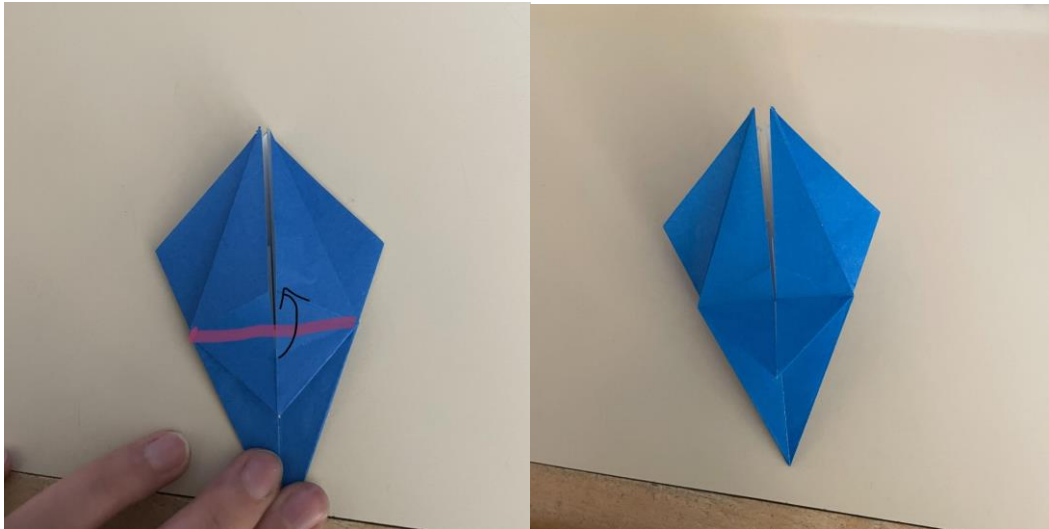
6, Fold in a line.



7, Fold along the crease line, opening and crushing the corners.

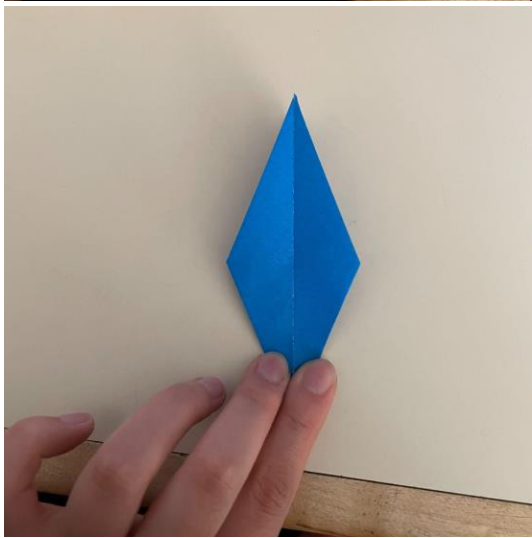
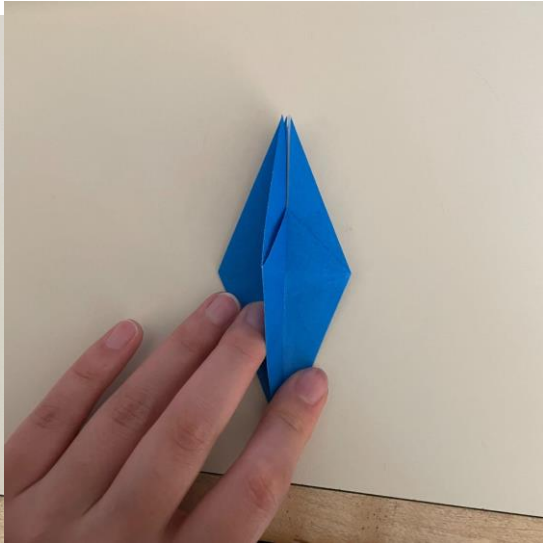
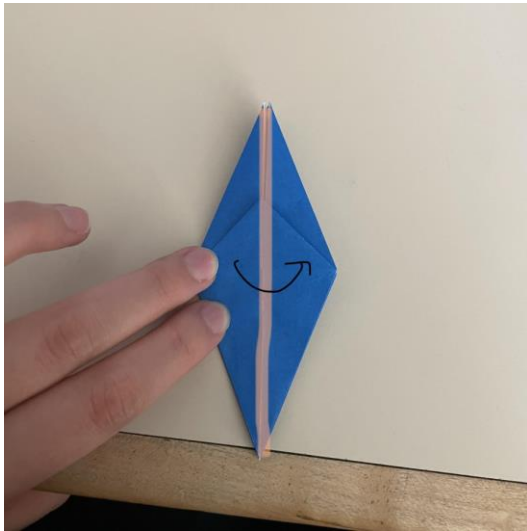


8, Fold up the corners with the line.



9, Do 6, 7, and 8 on the other three sides.

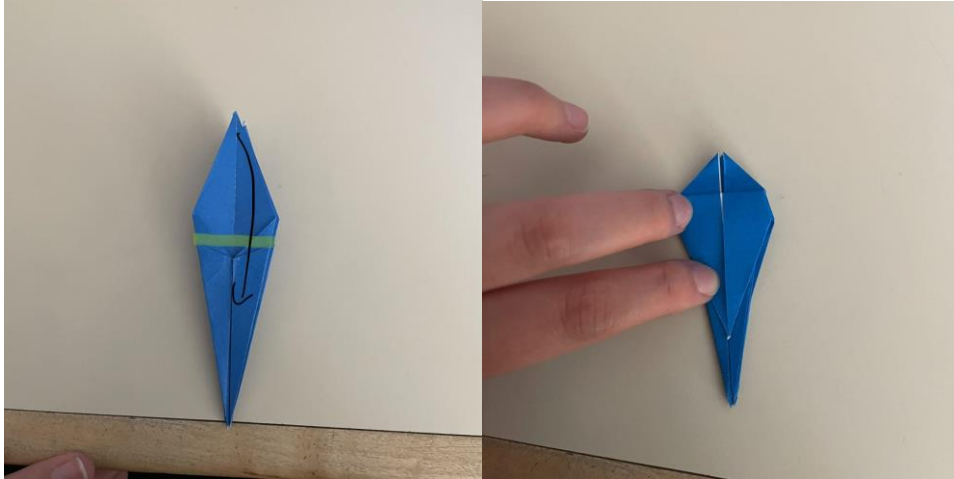
10, Turn one sheet over to reveal the unfolded side. Fold the remaining three sides in the same manner.



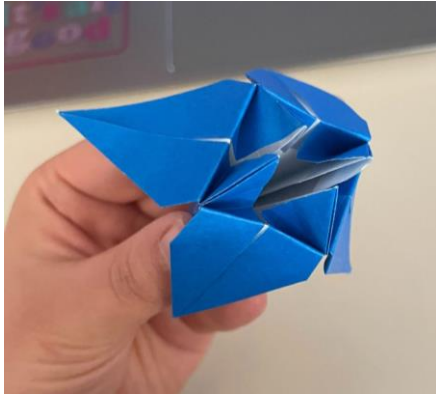
11, Fold in the line. Do it on the other three sides as well.



12, Fold in the line. Do it on the other three sides as well.



13, Spread the petals and center.



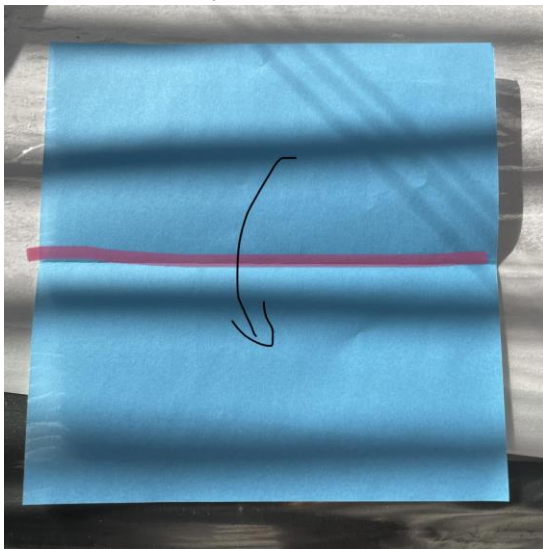
14, Wrap the petals around a round object and curl the end.



Gerbera



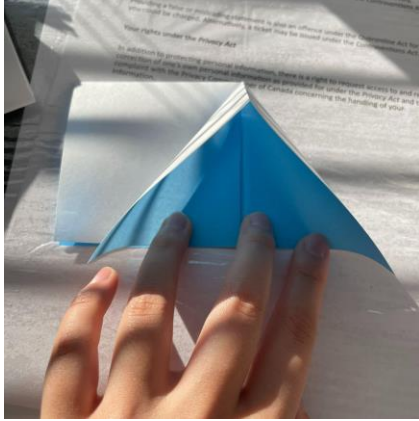
1, Fold the valley fold on the line.



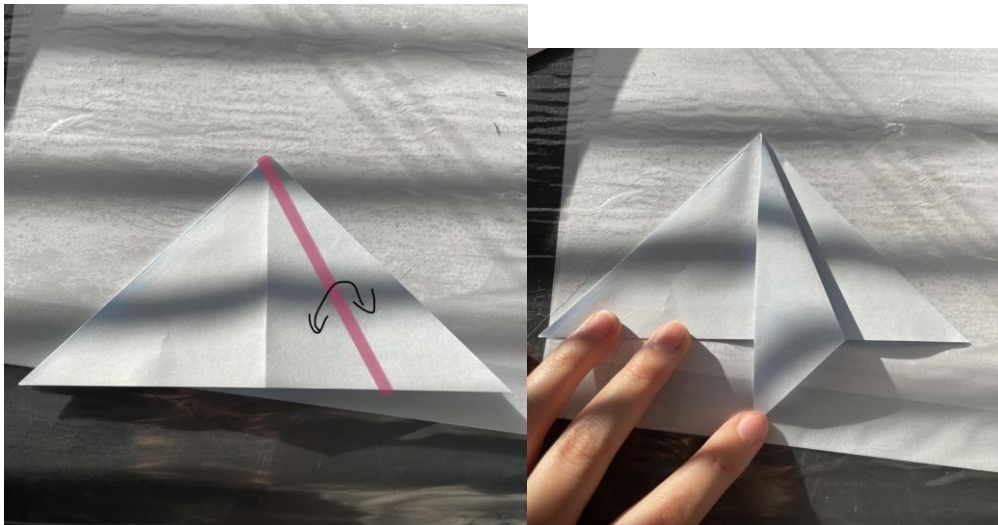
2, Fold the valley fold on the line.



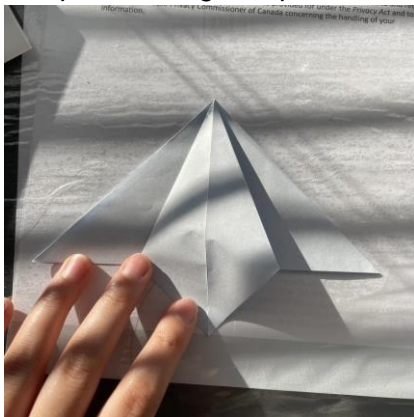
3, Next, open the bag as shown in the image and fold it up. Do the same thing on the other side.



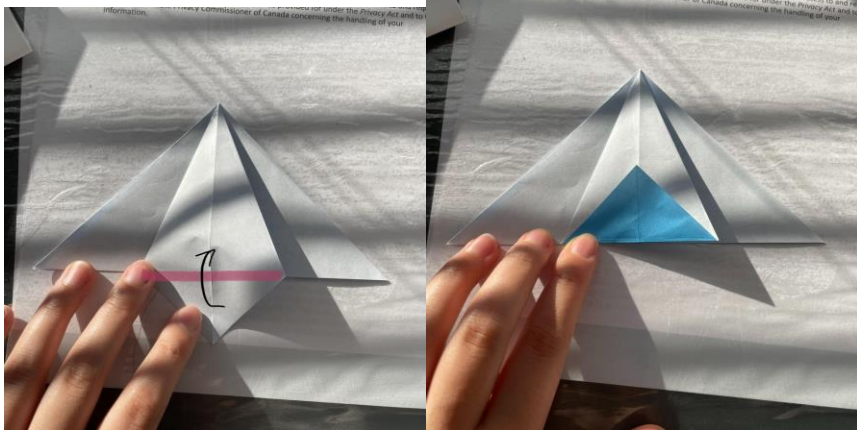
4, [Right side only] Fold with a valley fold on the line.



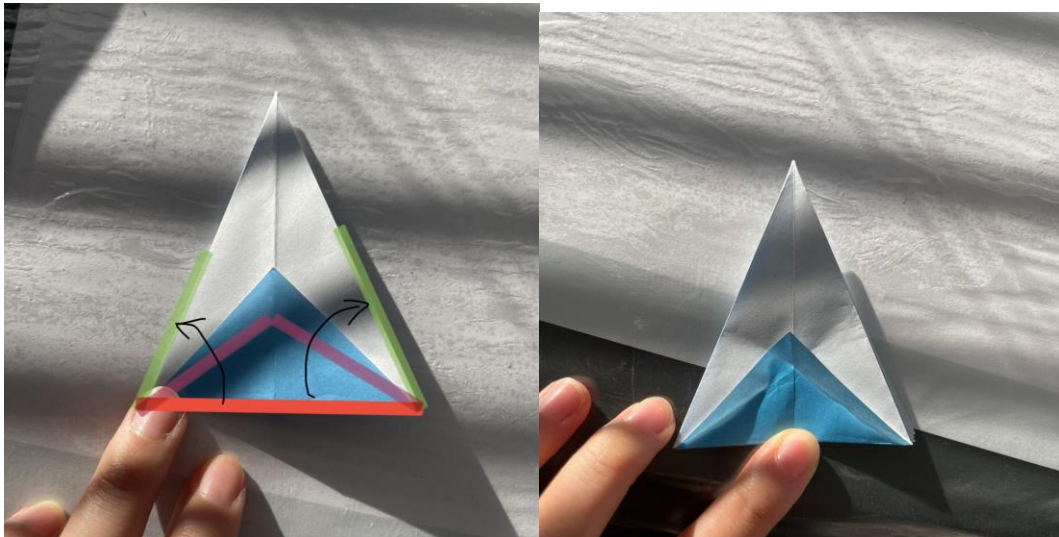
5, Open the bag and pull it out to the left as shown in the image.



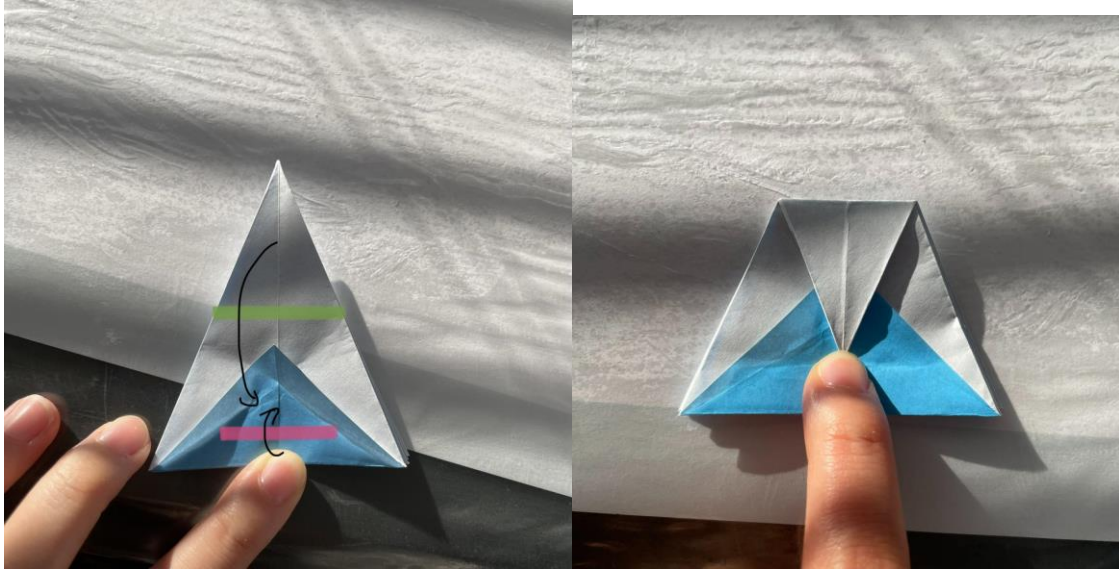
6, Make a valley fold on the line. Fold all other sides in the same way. Fold all other sides in the same way, 5 and 6.



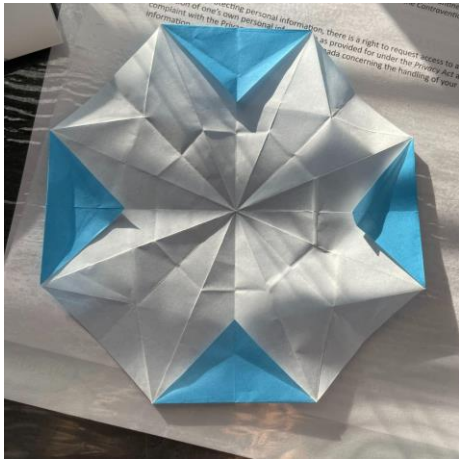
7, Fold each red line in line with the green line on either side, then fold in the purple valley fold line and crease. All other sides are also folded and creased.



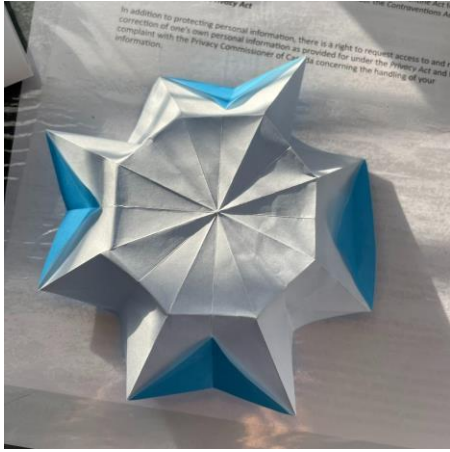
8, i) Align the yellow line with the blue arrow and fold back with a valley fold and a crease line on the line.
ii) Align the tip of the triangle with the fold crease made in step (i) and valley fold it with the green line.



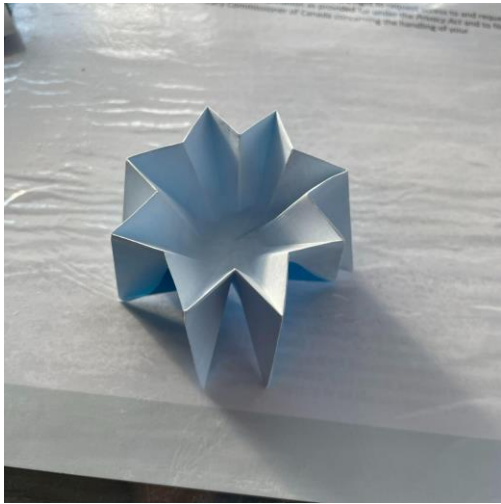
9, Spread it.



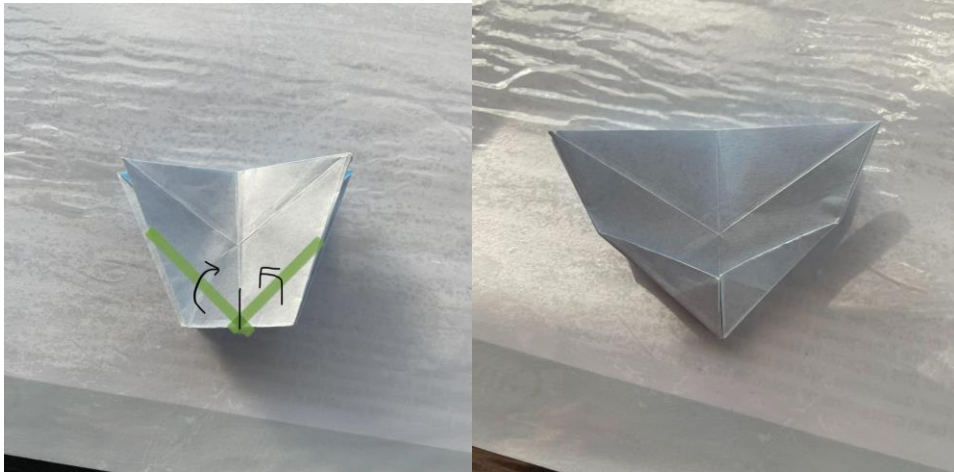
10, Using the reattached folded lines, pinch the corners of the octagon and bring it to the center as shown in the image.



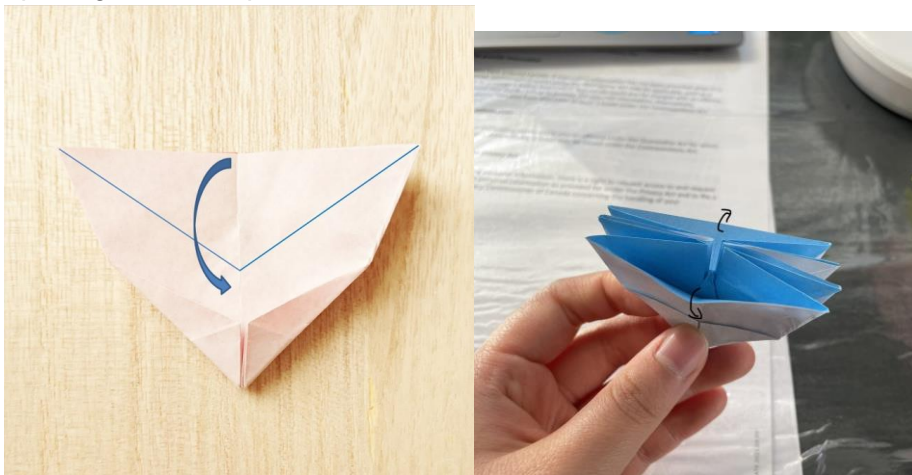
11, Gently pull it over so that the center is indented, and shape it into a star as shown in the image.



12, Place the star-shaped part down as shown in the image. Valley-fold the bottom corners on the lines. Fold all other sides in the same way.



13, Turn one edge toward you and fold up along the fold stripe. Do the same with the rest, opening the entire piece.



14, While gently pulling both ends of the left and right sides, open the center into a bag shape.



15, Wrap the tip outward.



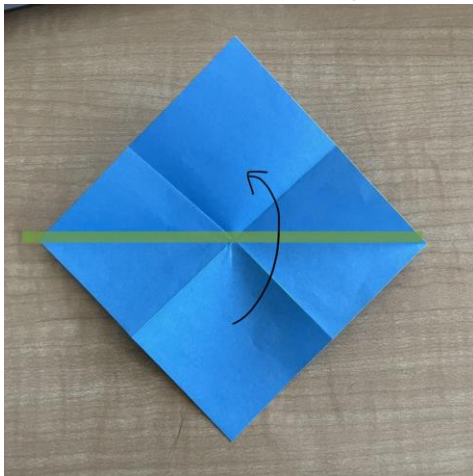

Flower of Cherry Blossoms

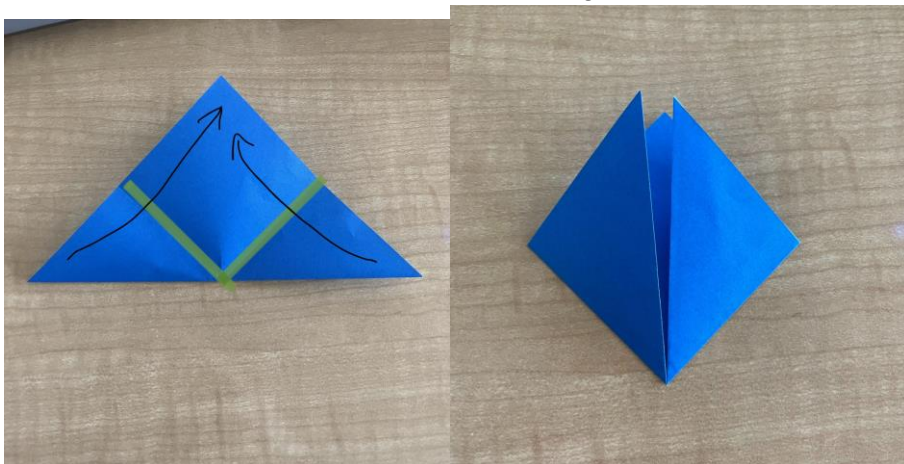
We use five pieces of quarter origami paper.



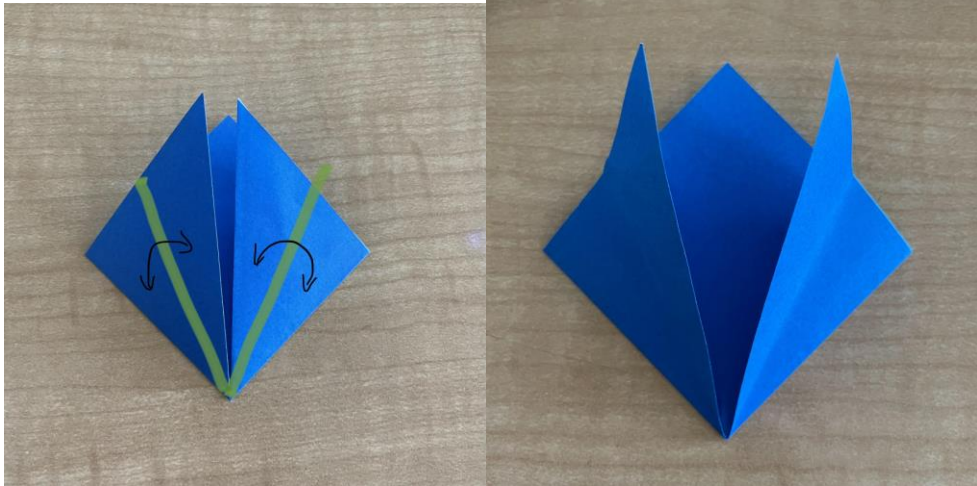
1, Place the reverse side up and fold it in half on the line.



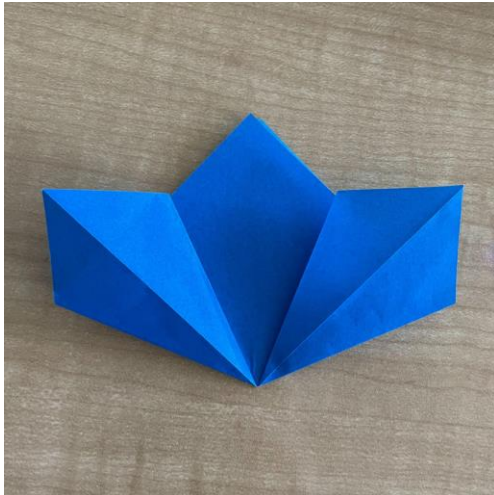
2, Fold in the lines so that the corners are aligned.



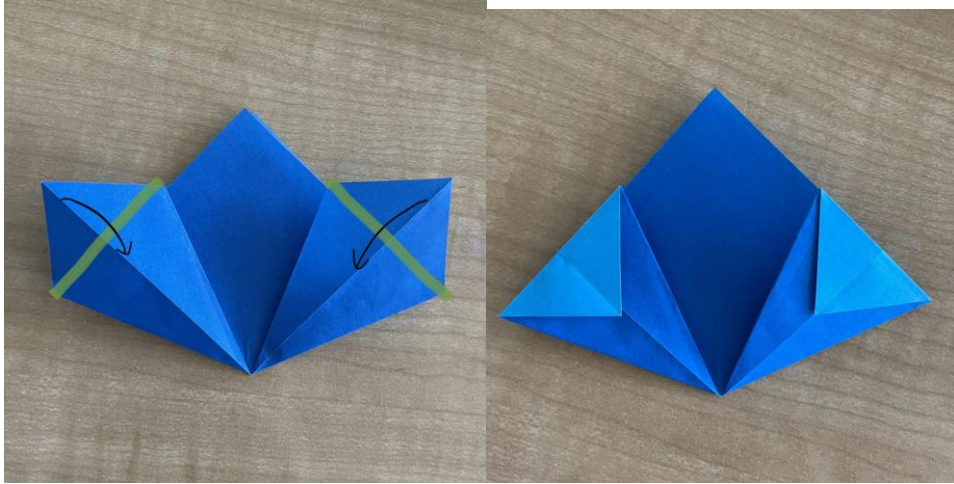
3, Fold in the lines so that the edges are aligned.



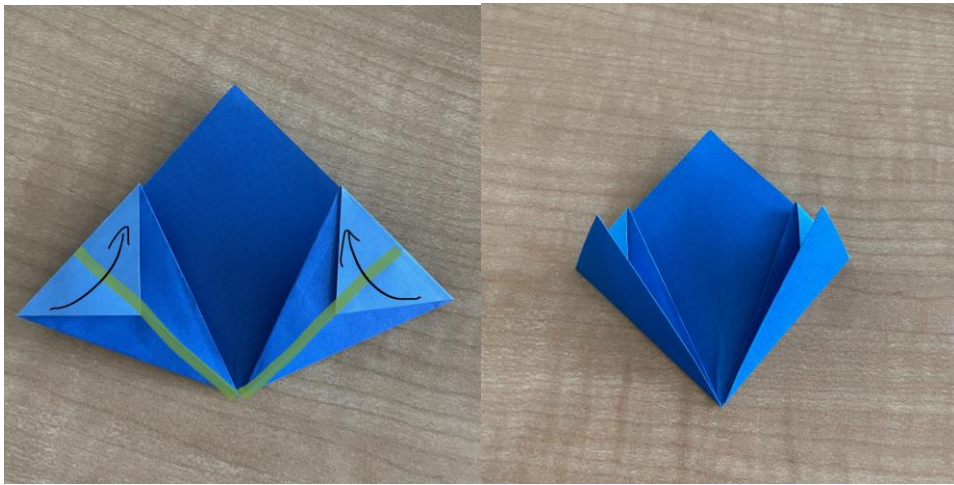
4, Fold the corners open along the crease line. Do the same thing on the other side.



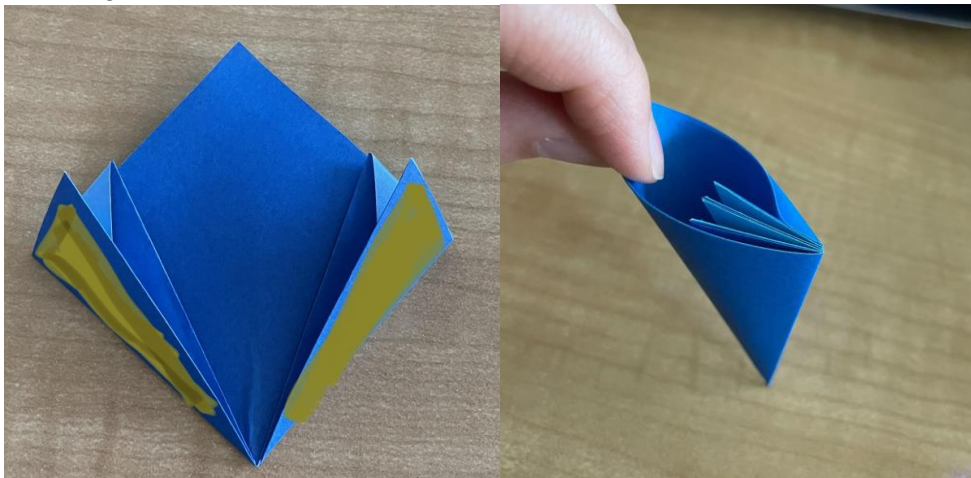
5, Fold in the lines.



6, Fold in the lines.



7, Apply glue to the area enclosed by the yellow color and paste it with the triangle facing it, rounding it off.



8, Make five of them in total.

9, Apply glue to the joints of each part and paste them together as shown in the image to complete the cherry blossom.
