

2. Mark the Cupola Base


Draw a center line on two opposite sides of the cupola base. Using your board template, make a line from each lower corner to the center line. This will be your cutting line. Start cuts at corners and end at center.

3. Position

Place caulked (as shown at right) pieces of 2 x 4 to be snug against the inside walls of the cupola base. Screw them into roof.

Drill holes to secure cupola to 2 x 4 pieces screwed to roof (see step 3).

After base is installed, caulk where base and roof meet on angle sides.

4. Mounting & Assembly

Attach the base to the 2×4 's. Once the base is secured to the roof, attach the mid section to the base using the screws (provided) in the pre-drilled holes. Install the roof in the same manner.
