## MEDICINES TO TAKE DURING TRAVELLING

Along with the prescribed medicines by the doctor, we need to take some additional medicines which are very useful during travel. They are -

- Antibiotic ointments to prevent infections in wounds, cuts and scrapes etc.
- Creams like <u>Burnol</u>, <u>Polysporin</u> etc which heals burns quickly.
- <u>Corticosteroid ointments</u> to give relief from itching and reduce inflammation from bites etc.
- Take medicines like <u>Acetaminophen</u>, <u>Ibuprofen</u>,
  <u>Paracetmol</u> to reduce headaches, fever, toothaches etc.
- <u>Digestive tablets</u> like <u>Digene</u>, <u>Enzyplex</u>, <u>Diagexo</u> etc to reduce the feeling of constipation and gas. These feelings are mainly caused by eating oily foods, outside foods etc.
- Also take medicines like <u>Combiflam</u>, <u>Volini</u> etc which are best in giving relief from Body pains, Joint pains etc

## OTHER THINGS TO TAKE ALONG WITH MEDICINES

- Adhesive bandages to cover the wounds and cuts which reduces the infection.
- Adhesive tape to stick and hold the bandages tightly and firmly.

- A small bottle of <u>Hydrogen Peroxide</u> and <u>Cotton swabs</u> which are used to remove the dust from nails and ears.
- A roll of Cotton is must while travelling because it -
- 1.) Helps in cleaning the wounds
- 2.) Used for applying ointments and creams
- 3.) It is also used for covering the cuts, burns etc.
