KNIT MUSTACHE PATTERN

to be used in conjunction with knit beard hat pattern

Yarn: Bulky. I recommend <u>Lion Brand Homespun</u> or <u>Red Heart Light & Lofty</u> (or similar)

Notes:

This pattern creates the beard and hat in one flat piece to be seamed together. Skills needed include Provisional Cast On, Kfb, K2tog. Piece is worked in garter stitch (knit each row).

Gauge:

10 sts + 16 rnds = 4 in. (10 cm) in St st (k every rnd). BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make a 4 in. (10 cm) square, try using smaller size needles; if more stitches and rows, try larger size needles.

Notes:

This pattern starts at one point of the mustache and works across to the other. Piece is worked in garter stitch (knit each row). Gauge will depend on the size of yarn.

Mustache:

CO 1

Row 1: Kfb (2 stitches at end of this row)

Row 2: Knit across

Row 3: Kfb, kfb (4 stitches)

Row 4: Knit

Row 5: Kfb, k2, kfb (6 stitches)

Row 6: Knit Row 7: Knit Row 8: Knit

Row 9: K2tog, k2, k2tog (4 stitches)

Row 10: Knit

Row 11: k2tog, k2tog (2 stitches)

Row 12: Knit

Row 13: Kfb, kfb (4 stitches)

Row 14: Knit

Row 15: Kfb, k2, kfb (6 stitches)

Row 16: Knit Knit Row 18: Knit

Row 19: K2tog, k2, k2tog (4 stitches)

Row 20: Knit

Row 21: k2tog, k2tog (2 stitches)

Row 22: Knit

Row 23: K2tog (1 stitch)

BO

CO (cast on)	Kfb Knit into front and then back of same st - 1 st increased.
BO (bind off)	K2юg Knit next two stitches together - 1 st decreased.
