## **SECRET PLACES TO HIDE MONEY**

1.) <u>Hiding in socks :-</u> This is a good idea and a good place to hide money. Any one can't predict that we will hide money in socks.



**2.)** Hiding in shoes: This idea sounds some embarassing. But it works for sure. Money is to be put in a plastic cover and put under the shoe. i.e We need to remove the insole part of the shoe and place the money cover and replace the insole. For information check the below picture.



**3.)** <u>Hiding in mobile phone</u>: This is the best idea for hiding money. Just remove the phone case and put the money cover and simply close the case as shown in the below picture.



**4.)** Hiding in Water bottle: We can also hide money in water bottle label. If we follow the below given instructions we can hide money in a water bottle.

## **HIDING MONEY IN WATER BOTTLE**

**Step 1: Apparatus** 



The items required for this instructable are as given below

- 1.) Two identical plastic water bottles with plastic cover on them.
- 2.) Quick Fix Adhesive
- 3.) One currency note

## **Step 2: Removing the covers**



First of all remove the plastic cover carefully which is sealed on the body of the water bottle. Then select one water bottle and put the other bottle aside.

**Step 3: Sticking the first cover** 



Now take one plastic cover which is unsealed from the water bottle and stick it to the water bottle which is selected as shown in the above figure using Quick Fix Adhesive.

**Step 4: Arranging the currency note** 



After the first cover is dried take a currency note and fold it into half and spread it on the body of the bottle on the first cover as shown in the above figure.

**Step 5: Covering the note** 



Now take the second plastic cover and roll it over the currency note which is spread over the body of the water bottle. And stick the cover to the bottle using Quick Fix Adhesive as in the case of first cover.
