

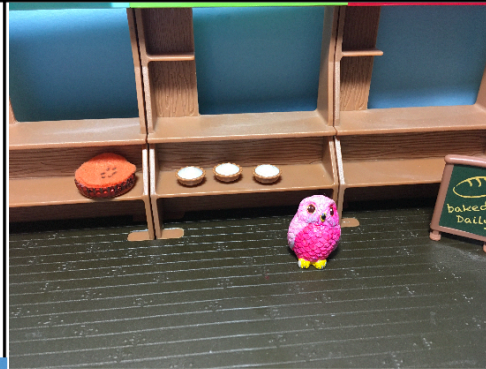
Pinka's Halloween Shop
